What is Shankranthi



Sankranti is the festival for harvesting seasonal crops, bringing great joy and festive mood to farmers.

Also called 'Makara Sankranti', it is celebrated primarily in the states of Andhra Pradesh, Karnataka & Maharashtra. From this day onwards the sun with respect to the earth starts moving towards north signaling the oncoming of summer.

Sankranti is often celebrated by distributing roasted white yellu (sesame seeds) and are distributed with small sweets, bits of coconut, fruit etc.

Cattle races are held in several parts of Karnataka on the streets during Sankranti. Races of small bullock carts are also held at special venues.

After the worship of Sun God, the farmers like to prepare their *pongal (Huggi)* (the special dish made of rice, in the field, followed by singing and dancing. Kite flying is traditional and common
